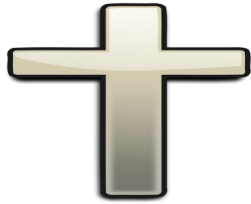

Divine Mercy Sunday/2nd Sunday of Easter

Jesus' mercy knows no bounds. He longs for us all to be saved—regardless of time, or how far one has strayed. Today's Gospel shows of the depth of God's mercy. Retelling the thousand-year-old story of "doubting Thomas," it provides the perfect passage for today, Divine Mercy Sunday. From this deep desire for the apostle Thomas to believe that he had truly risen, to his 20th century message to a Polish nun, Jesus has and always will, have an inconceivable mercy for us all. Today, let us all exclaim as Thomas did upon recognizing Jesus, "My Lord and my God!"

Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord | April 8

The Feast of the Annunciation marks the beginning of the Incarnation, an important event that allows us all to reflect on Mary's faith and humility in saying "yes" to God's call. As the Archangel Gabriel appears to a young Mary, announcing that she had been chosen by God to bear a son, she is afraid. Through divine revelation and intervention, Gabriel reassured Mary, allowing her to declare with love, "Let it be done to me according to your word," demonstrating her trust in God and willingness to participate in His plan for salvation. As we reflect on the Annunciation, we are called to imitate Mary's response to God, acting through faith and trust in God's providence. Much like Mary did, we often see God's promises in unexpected ways. Open your eyes to the ways in which his promises continue to be fulfilled in our lives!
